Sub: Grant of Conditional Permission to Yunus Fazlani Unani Medical College and Al-Fazlani Unani Hospital, 65MX+P26, Kunjkhedra-431103, Maharashtra with 50 seats in UG (BUMS) course for the academic session 2021-22 under section 28 of NCISM Act, 2020 and relevant regulations thereunder-regarding.

Sir/Madam,

With reference to the subject mentioned above, I am directed to inform you that in pursuance of the provisions of National Commission for Indian System of Medicine Act, 2020 the Indian Medicine Central Council Act, 1970 (48 of 1970) has been repealed with effect from the 11th day of June, 2021. With effect from the said date, the Central Council of Indian Medicine constituted under sub-section (1) of section 3 of the Indian Medicine Central Council Act, 1970 (48 of 1970) has been dissolved. Now, in exercise of the powers conferred by sub-section (3) of the section 1 of the said Act, the Central Government notified that all the provisions of the National Commission for Indian System of Medicine Act, 2020 has been come into force with effect from the 11th day of June, 2021. In view of the above, the Central Government constituted the Autonomous Boards with effect from 11th June, 2021 and as per regulation 59(2) of The National Commission for Indian System of Medicine ACT, 2020 Medical standards, requirements and other provisions of the Indian Medicine Central Council Act, 1970 and the rules and regulations made thereunder shall continue to be in force and operate till new standards or requirements are specified under this Act or the rules and regulations made thereunder.

Further, the provision of concerned regulations which are inconsistent with the provision of NCISM ACT, 2020 shall not be applicable.

1. However, GOI, Ministry of AYUSH vide its letter no. L.14011/3/2020-EP (1) dated 26.03.2021 and 15.04.2021 issued Relaxation/support policy for ASU&S colleges in unprecedented times of COVID-19 pandemic for the academic session 2021-22 and the college will be considered on the basis of part-I visitation proforma submitted by the college provided that the college shall submit an undertaking & indemnity bond, stating that they shall fulfill respective requirements in terms of required teaching and training facilities specified in the relevant regulations throughout the academic year. Further, as per point no. "P" of above said relaxation policy and as per direction of President, Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine, college was virtually visited on dated **13.10.2021**.

In view of above, the college had been assessed on the basis of Relaxation policy issued by the Ministry of AYUSH and visitation report submitted by the visitors. On examining in terms of Regulation 3 of the "Indian Medicine Central Council (Requirements of Minimum Standard for under-graduate Unani Colleges and attached Hospitals) Regulations, 2016", provisions under the NCISM Act, 2020 and relevant regulations thereunder, it was found that the College was not fulfilling notified and approved criteria for Granting Conditional Permission for UG (BUMS) for A.Y. 2021-22.

2. Further, on examining the same, certain deficiencies had been observed and therefore, under section 28 of NCISM Act 2020 and relevant regulations thereunder, **an opportunity of hearing was granted to the college on 31.12.2021 to present the case through virtual mode.**

The observations of hearing committee based on the submission made by the college representatives during hearing and assessment report of the NCISM have been carefully examined in terms of Regulation 3 of the "Indian Medicine Central Council (Requirements of Minimum Standard for under-graduate Unani Colleges and

attached Hospitals) Regulations, 2016" and relevant regulations thereunder, it is found that the College is fulfilling notified and approved criteria for granting Conditional Permission for UG (BUMS) for A.Y. 2021-22

3. Therefore, it has been decided by the President, Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine to grant Conditional Permission to **Yunus Fazlani Unani Medical College and Al-Fazlani Unani Hospital, 65MX+P26, Kunjkheda-431103, Maharashtra** with **50 seats in UG (BUMS) course** for the academic session 2021-22 subject to the following conditions:-
 - i. The fulfillment of conditions as specified in the Undertaking/Indemnity bond submitted by the college.
 - ii. The college shall submit an undertaking in the form of affidavit duly notarized within one month explaining the details of providing EPF and ESI facilities to the teaching, non-teaching staff of the Colleges/Hospitals and regularly paying the same as per the provisions of Employees' Provident Funds and Miscellaneous Provisions Act, 1952 & ESI Act, 1948 and relevant Rules and Regulations.
4. It is further informed that minimum 15% of undergraduate seats of the permitted intake capacity of 50 seats in UG (BUMS) course shall be treated as All India Quota. The counseling for seats under All India Quota shall be conducted by respective counseling authority as designated by Central Government for A.Y. 2021-22 and counseling for the remaining 85% seats or as the case may be, shall be conducted by the concerned Counseling Authority of that State/UT. **The permission of the college stands withdrawn if the college fails to comply with the aforesaid direction of the Central Government/NCISM for All India Quota or the students admitted thereunder.**
5. Admissions made in violation of the above conditions will be treated as invalid and action will be initiated under NCISM Act & Regulations thereunder.
6. Discrepancies, if any, may be immediately brought to the notice of Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine, NCISM.
7. The following requirements should be fulfilled by the institution before applying for the session 2022-23 (before opening of Part-I proforma) to get permission for the session 2022-23:
 - (i) all the requirements of Minimum Standard of infrastructure and teaching & training facilities as specified in Regulation 3 of the "Indian Medicine Central Council (Requirements of Minimum Standard for undergraduate Unani Colleges and attached Hospitals) Regulations, 2016;
 - (ii) all the requirements of the Indian Medicine Central Council (Minimum Standards of Education in Indian Medicine) Amendment Regulations, 2016 (for Unani); and
 - (iii) all the requirements under the provisions of the NCISM Act, 2020 and relevant Regulations made thereunder should be fulfilled in toto;
8. The fulfillment of the conditions given above may be made within the time period specified and compliance report should be submitted by the college to President, Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine. The Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine will verify that the conditions have been fulfilled for considering the permission from the academic session 2022-23.

(iii) Deficiencies regarding infrastructure and other facilities to be fulfilled as shown in Inspection Report.

(iv) Other :- Fees/-, Fine/Penalty/- (if any pending with College)

a. The College shall submit Affidavit in the prescribed format as per Academic Council's Resolution No. 229/2013 (Format attached).

b. Information of all College Teachers shall be updated on the University Academic Online Teachers Database & monthly review shall be taken by College Coordinator so as to ensure that teacher's information is regularly updated.

c. Those UG/PG qualifications that are not yet recognized by the Central Govt. it is mandatory for the college to apply to the Central Council through Central Govt. and ensure that Permitted/Not Recognized qualifications are enlisted in "Recognized Qualifications", failing which University shall not grant Continuation of Affiliation to such courses from ensuing Academic Year & no student shall be admitted in such courses.

2. You are requested to comply with the above mentioned deficiencies within the stipulated timewithout fail and submit compliance report.

Important Note:

- 1) The Continuation / Extension of Affiliation is issued for the Academic Year 2021-22 subject to the permission of Central Council of Ayurved and Unani, New Delhi/Govt. of India/Department of AYUSH, New Delhi and if the permission is declined by the said authorities this Continuation / Extension of Affiliation will be treated as cancelled. The college is not authorized to admit the students for 1st year of the course until receipt of permission of the Central Council of Ayurved and Unani, New Delhi/Govt. of India/Department of AYUSH, New Delhi.
- 2) The admission shall be done only through the Competent Authorities.
